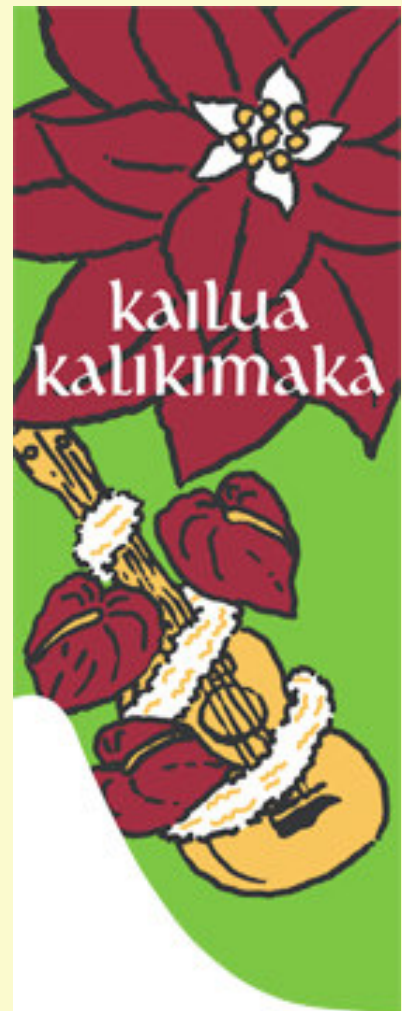

KVBID Board of Director Applications Available Soon

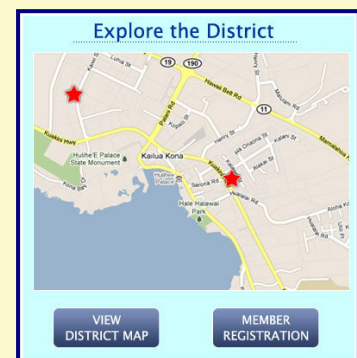
