
Gateways: Location 2 – Intersection of Queen Kaahumanu Hwy. and Palani Rd.






## **Recent Survey of Stakeholders**

Q3 What public space improvements would you like to see in Historic Kailua Village?






Q4 What are the biggest challenges facing Historic Kailua Village?
