



New Security Services Added

The Security Ambassadors are walking and on bikes in the Village during the daytime hours starting at 7 am and in a roving vehicular patrol until 11 pm. Trained on panhandling, loitering protocols and best practices, the team has also gone through 4 hours of Mental Health Awareness Training.



KVBID worked with local artist Cindy Foster to brand the fence surrounding the sewage lift station near Kailua Pier.






KVBID has altered the physical environment in some places by trimming up trees to make certain areas less hospitable for criminal activity.

Phase One work has begun with the planting of the Hala trees!






